The City of Montague will hold a Public Workshop on Thursday, December 8, 2022, at 3:00 p.m. in the City of Montague Council Chambers, at 230 South 13th Street, Montague, California on the following item:

CITY OF MONTAGUE HOUSING ELEMENT UPDATE

The City of Montague is hosting a public workshop to discuss a proposed update of the City's Housing Element. The Housing Element is a policy document used by the City to address its future housing needs, including affordable housing for lower income households. The Housing Element describes housing needs and sets forth goals and implementation programs intended to address these housing needs. The document is an expression of local commitment to act in a progressive fashion to utilize the public and private resources of the City in response to the challenge of providing decent and affordable housing in a pleasant environment for all residents. The Housing Element was last updated in March 2014. An adopted Housing Element consistent with state requirements is necessary to qualify for Community Development Block Grant programs, which the City has been using for years to aid in the rehabilitation of local housing.
